#### Dear Friends,

I thought I might take the opportunity of writing to you as we begin the next stage of the roadmap to recovery from the Covid 19 lockdown.

Our pattern of Sunday worship has almost returned to what it was in early 2020 (with the exception that there is not yet a monthly Sung Evensong on the 3rd Sunday of the month in Thorp Arch). As has been our custom, August will feature a Benefice service in a single church each week, but in September, the usual pattern will resume. This marks the end of the longest period of disruption to Church services since 1208!

In our Benefice we have tried to follow advice and best practice from the Government and the Church of England in order to keep people as safe as possible, but to honour our obligations of communal prayer and worship as best we can. We have also tried to do what we can to serve and support each other during this difficult period. There is now a real prospect of moving forward without the risk of serious disruption later in the year. We will have to live with some of the risks of Covid 19 for some time but vaccination has made such a difference and many of us will, I suspect, find that regular vaccination becomes part of our lives as we move forward. Please take these opportunities for vaccination and encourage others to do so.

As our service pattern resumes there remain some restrictions regarding masks and singing, but we hope and pray that these will be lifted as we move forwards. Please remember that even after restrictions are lifted (we presume from 19 July), that if you feel more comfortable in a mask you are welcome to continue to wear one. It is not yet clear whether the chalice will be resumed nationally, and I would be interested to know people's thoughts and levels of comfort about this, pending whatever new national advice is received. It may be that some flexibility regarding receiving the Sacraments will be made available as I rather suspect that people will have different levels of comfort about sharing the common cup in the light of what we have all lived through. I do not want people to feel reluctant to come to church because of the common cup, but also do not wish to deprive those for whom its absence has been grieving them. We shall find a way together I am sure, but it would be useful for me to know people's feeling on this matter in the meantime. So at this time we look forward with hope, longing to be together and to stay together but aware of the challenges and opportunities of this coming year. Please pray for our churches and our communities, our families, friends and neighbours as we plan and work together in moving forward after such a difficult and challenging time.
