

Diocese of York Family Camp 9th - 11th June

Families of all shapes and sizes will be arriving at Wydale on **June 9th** for a weekend of fun, games, food and hanging out.

From Friday evening through to Sunday afternoon the fun will include organised games, crafts, worship, treasure hunts, bedtime stories, hot chocolate and maybe a campfire if the weather allows. It will be a chance for families to explore together the Diocese of York Rhythm of Life resources.

The event is being organised by Diocesan Children & Youth consultant Carolyn Edwards, who has enormous enthusiasm and expertise for sharing God's word across all ages, so expect the event to be educational and fun in equal measures.

Campers can arrive from 4.00pm on Friday 9th June and leave after lunch on Sunday 11th June. Camping will be in the field next door to the Emmaus Centre, close to their facilities, and limited indoor accommodation is available. Meals will be provided in the Emmaus dining hall and all food, refreshments and resources are included in the weekend price.

Weekend tickets are £25 for adults, £18 for teens and £13 for children. A discounted ticket for up to six family members is available for £90. Indoor accommodation is subject to availability and costs an additional £5 per person.
