



An ecologically-themed week of fun, following the story of Creation in the Bible to help us explore how we care for our planet and one another. Join us for games, crafts, Bible stories, songs, drama, fun & friendship.

HOLIDAY CLUB 2023

for school children from Year 2 upwards

GOD SAW THAT IT WAS GOOD! is a children's holiday club (five weekday morning sessions) running Monday 31st July to Friday 4th August 2023, 10am - 1pm each day

During the week, we will have great fun with Tracy the dinosaur, and will be using the story of Creation from the Bible to think about how God loves the world and us, and how we can love our wonderful world too! This is not an exploration of "creationism" but focuses on Biblical themes of God as our loving Creator, and our duty to love what God has made, including one another. There will be a strong ecological and natural science theme to the week. We will have games, drama, crafts, songs and lots of fun.

Dress code: just rock up in anything comfortable.

There are strictly limited numbers to ensure the enjoyment and safety of all the young people who attend, so please fully complete our registration form. opposite (one per child and both sides please) then detach and send to St. Mary's Church, Boston Spa and complete one for each child attending. Places will be filled really quickly so get your registration back as soon as possible but no later than MONDAY 10th July please.

Young helpers: Young people who are currently in Year 6 or older are welcome to volunteer. Please complete the section on the registration form or contact us for more information. We may have more young people than places so please note that priority will be given to those who regularly attend our youth group.

DONATIONS: This is a self-funding holiday club paid for by generous donations made by parents, parishioners, carers and families of the young people who attend. We do not get any additional funding from the Church of England, Government, Education Department or Council and ALL the 'person power' is given free of charge!

A suggested £2.50 per child per morning donation towards the cost of Holiday Club would be most appreciated, and please don't forget to sign the Gift Aid section so that we can claim some money back from the tax man! We must stress that those young people whose circumstances mean that they are unable to make a donation are still very welcome to attend the holiday club - any donation you make is voluntary.

This year we are again supporting a special scheme - so if you are able to increase your donation above the requested £2.50 each day, then the additional donations will go to Away From It All Holidays (AFIA) - a Mother's Union holiday scheme which provides holidays for those families who would be unable to afford them otherwise. On average, Mothers' Union helps 2,500 people to have a holiday each year. Families are able to spend time together away from their stressful situations at home, engage in activities together and have fun.
