

Wrap up warm as we gather around an imaginary campfire in a cold church as a tale is told, truth is pondered, and a pint in a warm pub is anticipated...



Through the season of Advent, we focus on themes including Hope, Love, Joy, and Peace as we prepare our hearts to celebrate the birth of Jesus.

In these tales (and a short reflection and prayer after each one) the author ponders these Advent themes.

The sessions are short (half an hourish) and conclude with an optional pint with the author in The Crown.

Flourish is an oasis of calm reflection in which we explore a rhythm of life which enables us to flourish and become more like Christ.

I have attended many Zoom courses this week as part of York Diocese Safeguarding Week. Below is one of the activities I completed. At first, I was a little resistant to the idea of standing outside in the wind and rain, but I did it, and I'm so glad I did. Have a look at the activity below and give it a go.

A Walk of Awareness

Don't feel you have to follow every suggestion below, it is more important to take your time, experience and be mindful.

On your walk, either stop or walking slowly, take in the whole scene around you......

Then standing still close your eyes.

Listen, attend to the sounds the more you listen the more you will hear. Try not to analyse too much, simply listen and attend.

Feel your hands limbs and feet. Feel the ground beneath your feet, if you are walking feel the movement of the muscles and body as you move.

Then look.

Look down at the things around your feet, attend to the colours and textures and patterns of light and shade. Then in the same way look up at the sky and tree tops or roof tops and look around you.... Taking your time looking at the big picture then at the detail.

As you walk, pause to **touch** things and explore the feel and texture, smell the **scents** and if appropriate **taste**, perhaps chew a blade of grass or an edible berry.

By using one sense at a time and lingering, you experience more fully and deeply.

Towards the end of the walk you might want to pray thanksgiving or praise, or reflect what image/experience of the walk you take with you, but for most of the walk stay in the present moment and experience.
