Bramham Community Fund

The Bramham Community Fund exists to distribute the money generated by Festival Republic from the sale of residents' tickets at the Leeds Festival together with other donations made directly by the promoter. The requirement is that funds are to be used for the benefit of the community of Bramham. Since the Leeds Festival moved to Bramham in 2003, the Fund has allocated grants to a value of over £470,000.

The last allocation of grants, took place in March 2023. It is planned that the allocations from the 2023 Festival will be considered in March 2024.

The Fund is therefore now inviting applications.
The closing date is 14 February 2024

To keep it simple, there is no formal application form. Just write to the Bramham Community Fund c/o Colin Pool at 7 Prospect Bank, Bramham, LS23 6RS or send an email to colin.pool@empiconsulting.co.uk saying what you would like a grant for, how much and why.

The Fund committee under the chairmanship of Nick Lane Fox will then meet to consider the applications. Proposed projects should normally be completed within one year of the grant being awarded. If a project is expected to exceed that timescale, the application should indicate as such.

You should be aware that in the past preference in the allocation of grants has been given to new projects rather than funding the ongoing support of existing activities.

Applications cannot be accepted from individuals, commercial organisations or for projects which do not directly benefit residents of Bramham.



TRAFFIC MANGEMENT: Highways have yet to move the 30mph sign from the end of Toulston Lane (virtually at the apex of the junction with Aberford Road) back towards Tadcaster and site it adjacent to the Welcome Stone. LCC will be further reminded of this agreed repositioning of the sign. They will also be chased regarding the delay in erecting the extra three Speed Indicator Units, agreed almost 2 years ago. Council was fortunate that all three Ward Councillors were present to hear the discussion.

NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN: It is approximately 5 years since the Plan was "made" and adopted and it is now time to consider reviewing the document to ensure it is still relevant for the next 5years. A Working Group of three Councillors has been asked to consider how this may be most appropriately approached.

FOOTBALL PITCHES: At present the football pitches are rated as "poor", a result of many years of lack of specific maintenance. A Working Group has been set up to coordinate the application for grants from the Football Association for pitch improvements, the purchase of any necessary equipment to effect those improvements and the application to LCC for Planning Permission to establish a storage area in the compound behind the Pavilion for the safe storage of the equipment.



CLERGY KETTER FOR DECEMBER/JANUARY

Dear Friends.

As we enter the colder darker evenings, when the sun seems to barely rise enough for us to bask in any warmth, it is a good time to take some time out; wrap up warmly and find somewhere comfortable to sit and do a little bit of thinking about the past year.



It is a time to look back on the events which have shaped our lives and how these events have changed us or made us think differently. Starting with the most personal events we move on to those of our closest family, then wider family, friends, neighbours, work colleagues, our country, the world. Always considering how these events have made a difference to us and our thinking.

I'll give you an example. This year I had an operation which made me think differently about my sight. My daughter is getting married, this has made me think about the importance of good relationships. My cousin died and this reminds me of how important it is to keep in touch with those you love even if they live a long way away. I have made new friends and this has brought delight. Neighbours have been pleased to chat and talk about gardening. I have listened to a work colleague as they try to make sense of a challenging situation. Watching the Coronation of King Charles III knowing that so many others were witnessing the same thing. Then watching the news as reports of earthquakes, flooding, wildfires, melting ice shelves cause me to think more compassionately about our planet.

Some of these might resonate with you; diagnosis and treatment, relationships, bereavement, friendships, shared delights and common struggles. All these things change us whether we want them to or not. Maybe we should think about these changes more?

As Christians, when we are thinking about the time that has past it is good to place our thoughts into the presence of God. Give thanks for the things which have been good or positive, and give thanks for the challenges which have grown our confidence or understanding of an issue. If we find ourselves in any kind of pain then we can ask God to help us bear that pain and to bless others who might share in that situation.

This is called The Examen Prayer. Many people do this daily before they go to bed, as a final thanksgiving before sleeping. It is a positive way to reflect on the days' events and share with God what has been good and fruitful and also what has not been so good. It is a time to give thanks for the day and to acknowledge the times we have been cheered, challenged or changed.

Looking back on this last year I wonder what have been your personal times of cheer, challenge or change. I wonder how you feel about that?

Wishing you all a blessed and peace filled Advent and Christmas as you look back and give thanks.


