





YOU'RE INVITED TO AN EVENING OF... We are the Boston Spa Accessibility Group and we have been running a Facebook Page for a while now. A range of issues have been raised by members. We held the first group meeting recently, kindly hosted by Box Tree Court. We had three councillors, a representative from Boston Spa surgery and most importantly lots of interested local residents.

We spoke about access issues to shops and found out that Cohens Chemist now has a mobile ramp and grab rail. Andrew Morgan Opticians also has a mobile ramp. We want to see more improvements in this area, so more people can access their community.

We discussed disability parking, pavement parking and the problems it brings, as well as wheelie bins being left blocking paths. We talked about making sure the review of the Boston Spa Neighbourhood Plan takes accessibility into account and makes it a priority.

Lots of ideas were put forward about sharing information about cafes/restaurants that are accessible, shops becoming more accessible and encouraging shops to support the sunflower lanyard campaign and forget me not schemes.

Some of our group attended the Parish Council meeting this month to highlight concerns about the pavement parking in front of Costcutter in particular. The Parish Council have indicated additional measures will be considered to reduce this including additional planters which are fixed in position, bollards and signage.

It is an exciting time to join our Facebook group and get your voices heard. If you or someone you know is interested please join us. We are interested to hear from those with lived experience and also those who want to be allies to our whole community.
