



# The Challenge of Acts

The Acts of the Apostles is St Luke's sequel to his Gospel account. Led by our vicar, The Reverend Nick Morgan, the course takes as its starting point "The Challenge of Acts" by Tom Wright, published only last year, which is described as "a crash course on the book of Acts and its relevance for Christianity and culture today".






