Brief History of St Luke's, Clifford

St Luke's, Clifford is an inclusive, friendly and welcoming church where we seek to share the love of Christ and worship God in spirit and in truth. Our worship is in the Liberal Catholic Tradition. The Gospel, the Eucharist, service of God and neighbour, and the radical inclusive love of Jesus Christ lie at the centre of our worship and parish life.

An elegant little church and a prominent object of interest in the surrounding neighbourhood. Designed by Messrs. Atkinson of York and built in the form of a cross, with a lofty, vaulted roof.

The Church was designed by J B Atkinson, the architect also of St James, Wetherby (consecrated in the same year) as well as the Methodist Chapel in Boston Spa.

The foundation stone was laid by Miss Lane Fox of Bramham Park on St Luke's Day 1840 and consecrated by the 85 year old Archbishop of York, Edward Venables Vernon Harcourt, on 8th June 1842.

The main cost of the building and the churchyard wall and entrance gates, estimated at £1600, was raised by public subscription. The Patronage of St Luke's Church was granted to George Lane Fox in view of his extensive benefactions.
